From Highway 64 East:

Take the first exit past I-95 toward Red Oak (Should see signs for Northern Nash HS, Nash Central HS, and Nash Community College)
Turn left onto Old Carriage Rd.
Continue straight through the next stop light
Nash Central will be approx. 1 mile on the left

From Highway 64 West:

Take the first exit past exit 461 (it is not numbered) toward Red Oak (Should see signs for Northern Nash HS, Nash Central HS, and Nash Community College)
Turn right onto Old Carriage Rd.
Continue straight through the next stop light
Nash Central will be approx. 1 mile on the left

From I-95 North:

Take exit 138 to merge onto US-64 W toward Nashville
Take the first exit toward Red Oak (Should see signs for Northern Nash HS, Nash Central HS, and Nash Community College)
Turn left onto Old Carriage Rd.
Continue straight through the next stop light
Nash Central will be approx. 1 mile on the left

From I-95 South:

Take the first exit past exit 461 (it is not numbered) toward Red Oak (Should see signs for Northern Nash HS, Nash Central HS, and Nash Community College)
Turn right onto Old Carriage Rd.
Continue straight through the next stop light
